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PORT NETWORKS TO OPEN OFFICE IN WORLD TRADE CENTER OF BALTIMORE

Baltimore, MD - January 6, 2003 – Port Networks, LLC, a wireless Internet service provider serving the Baltimore market, today announced that it has signed a lease on new office space in the World Trade Center of Baltimore, located at 401 East Pratt Street in downtown Baltimore.

As the hub of commercial trade for the Port of Baltimore, the World Trade Center serves a wide variety of tenants, including shipping agents, law firms, and technology companies. The unique, pentagonal skyscraper was constructed in 1976 and has been a landmark of the Baltimore skyline ever since.

"We're pleased by the opportunity to lease office space in one of the city's premier buildings," says Hugh Bethell, Port Networks' General Manager. "We're looking forward to working side by side with companies that also serve the Port of Baltimore."

The World Trade Center is operated by the Maryland Port Administration, which is responsible for general management of the Port of Baltimore. The Center offers its tenants shared services, harbor views, open floor plans, full building security, and easy access to the restaurants and retailers located in downtown and the Inner Harbor.

Starting January 8, 2003, Port Networks will be locating its administrative personnel and network operations center in the World Trade Center. Soon thereafter, the company will be installing equipment on the building's roof to broadcast and receive wireless broadband data signals.
